# Olivia Golf Club Information

The following information is for the guidance of and observance  
by Olivia Golf Club members:

## COURSE ETIQUETTE

1. Course open to the public for green fees on Mondays.
2. Course closed to women and non-sponsored green fees after 12:00 noon each Tuesday (Men's Day)
3. Course closed to men until after 4:00 p.m. each Thursday (Ladies' Day). This 4:00 p.m. time will be extended as required on Ladies' Guest Day, Ladies' Club Tournament Day or special events.
4. Junior Members:
  - a. Junior members will observe Men's and Ladies' Day restrictions.
  - b. Junior members may not golf after 6:00 p.m. on any day or anytime Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays, unless accompanied by a parent or an adult member, except with permission of a clubhouse attendant.
5. Also see 'Riding Cart' Rules on page 5.
6. Driving Range Use:
  - a. Members and/or guests of members.
  - b. Course guest prior to a tournament.
  - c. Balls are provided.
  - d. Irons only. All practice with long irons needs to be used with caution, and within the designated practice area.
  - e. Hours: 9:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

## CLUBHOUSE HOURS

The clubhouse will be open at 9:00 a.m. and remain open until 9:00 p.m. Monday-Friday from the first of April through the last day of October. There will be earlier opening times on Saturday & Sunday during the summer months. Hours will be extended on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday as the need arises. Weather may cause the clubhouse to be closed.

## CLUBHOUSE RENTAL FEES

The clubhouse is available for member-sponsored parties. The rental fee is \$200.00 to use the dining room and/or kitchen for ALL events. Contact the Manager at the clubhouse to fill out the rental agreement, or call 320-523-2313 for more information.

## LATE FEES

All unpaid playing members will have a \$10.00 assessment increase effective May 1. Dues must be paid or arrangements made with the manager for payment prior to first use of the club facilities. Any member's account that is not paid in full by June 1, is considered past due and must be paid before any club or course privileges can be given. After September 1, interest will be charged at a rate of 1% per month until balance is paid in full. Membership expires January 1 of the following year.

## Guest & Non-Member Information

Residents of Olivia, Bird Island, and Danube who are not members of the Olivia Golf Club may pay green fees throughout the year on Mondays. Other than Monday, non-members may pay green fees and play up until June 1 and then again after September 1.

Members may sponsor one guest on Men's Day or Ladies' Day and the member must play with the guest. A guest can be invited by a member once each season. Non-members with Olivia, Bird Island, and Danube addresses cannot be invited as a guest on Men's Day from June 1 through August 31, and Ladies' Day at any time, other than on the designated "Ladies' Guest Day" in June. Guests are required to pay green fees.

Under-age guests, junior or student members are not allowed in the clubhouse or on the golf course during Men's Day or Ladies' Day. The course is closed to non-sponsored green fees after 12:00 p.m. each Tuesday.

## Member Information

If you have decided not to join the club this season, we would appreciate a call to let us know if your membership plans have changed for this year. Call the manager at the clubhouse (523-2313) and let them know of your decision. Then, we don't need to continue sending you a membership statement.

It is the policy of the Olivia Golf Club and its Board of Directors that all memberships for each year be paid in full by May 1. There is an incentive that was adopted where members who paid their dues in full before March 1 received two complimentary nine-hole green fee passes, newly added this year, if you pay in full by February 1, you will receive four free passes. This policy will continue again this year. The majority of the members took care of their dues by March 1 or made payment arrangements. The Board has adopted the position that by June 1, if your membership has not been paid, you will no longer have access to the golf course facilities.

### **PAYMENT PLAN**

The Board created a payment plan allowing members to post-date checks for payment of their dues. Members are allowed to write up to five equal checks to cover their membership that are to be dated March 1, April 1, May 1, June 1, and July 1. Each check will be deposited shortly after the check date. The payment plan **MUST** start by March and be **completed by July 1.**

## Men's Day Only

1. Each member may sponsor one social guest or one golfing guest. If the guest is a golfing guest, he is expected to pay green fees or the member may pay his green fees for him.
2. Each sponsor is expected to play golf with his golfing guest. Courtesy demands that a guest not be sent on the course by himself.
3. Only shareholders on the course. No high school or college students or persons under 21 years of age on the course, including practice areas, after 12:00 noon, Tuesdays. Students playing under a family membership cannot play.

## Water Containers

As a reminder to the membership we do not provide drinking water on the golf course during your round of play. We control all that with a water cooler on the bar or with one of the staff.

Please bring your own water container from home. The more Styrofoam we give out, the more cost and waste the club has to incur. Please remind your family members to bring their own water container and we will be more than happy to fill it up for them.

Together this is a great initiative for all of us to work on together

## Riding Carts

1. The undisciplined use of riding carts presents a course maintenance problem and also a hazard to other golfers. The use of riding carts will be restricted if regulations pertaining to them are ignored.
2. Drive on the cart paths or in the rough as much as possible
3. Do not drive within 20 feet of the side or back of a green or within 30 feet of the front of the green. Please use paths around tees and greens. (See page 11)
4. Observe cart signs. Holes #5 and #9 are "cart path only."
5. Never more than three riding carts in a foursome or playing group.
6. Children under age 16 may not drive Olivia Golf Club owned riding carts at any time, unless accompanied by a parent or an adult member.
7. **Only two people per cart-always.**

### SAFETY

The pond is ten feet deep on the north end. This area is not a playground for anyone. All members are urged to insure that nobody, especially children, is playing in this area. It is the responsibility of every member to ensure safety and the proper use of our golf club and the course.

## General Rules

### 1. GREEN FEES:

Weekdays:.....\$16.00/9 holes.....\$23.00/18 holes  
Tuesdays/Weekends:.....\$18.00/9 holes.....\$27.00/18 holes  
Cart Rental:.....\$15.00/9 holes.....\$25.00/18 holes

### 2. All members and guests MUST check in before each round.

3. Each golfer must have their own golf bag and golf clubs.

4. Golfers will wear shirts and shoes at all times on the golf course.

5. Keep cans and litter off the course.

6. Slow play is not enjoyable - keep moving. If looking for a lost ball, please allow the group following you to play through. (*Rules of Golf allow three minutes to look for a lost ball.*)

7. Repair divots on all tees and fairways, and ball marks on greens.

8. There will be no charges in the Pro Shop or Clubhouse

9. Dues must be PAID IN FULL to participate in tournaments.

10. No carry-on beverages. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from the clubhouse.

11. Driving range is for members and/or guests of members. You are responsible for any damages or broken windows. Please be aware of golfers on #8.
